


# FREE PATTERN DOWNLOAD \( \bar{\parabola} \) Cozy Cat House



# Cosy cat house

With this cosy little house, your cat (or dog) can become the real star of the family.

### MATERIALS

- \*\* Jersey yarn (bulky
   \* thickness): ½ a ball
   each of royal blue,
   fuchsia and taupe
- Jersey yarn (medium thickness): remnants of orange
- \* N/15 (10mm)
  crochet hook
- \* Inner cardboard frame, length: 31cm (12in), height: 33cm (13in), depth: 34cm (13½in)
- \* Patterned material for the curtains: 40 x 80cm (153/4 x 311/2in)
- Sewing needle

# TECHNIQUE USED Crochet

### STITCHES USED

- Double crochet (dc)/ UK treble (tr)
- \* Chain stitch (ch)
- Single crochet (sc)/ UK double crochet (dc)

The house consists of several panels that cover an inner cardboard frame. The panels are made from rows of double (UK treble) stitches.

### THE TOP

Rows 1 to 10: with fuchsia yarn: 3 ch, 19 dc (UKtr).

### THE BOTTOM

Rows 1 to 10: with royal blue yarn: 3 ch, 19 dc (UKtr).

### THE SIDES AND THE BACK

Rows 1 to 5: with royal blue yarn: 3 ch, 19 dc (UKtr).

Rows 6 to 11: with taupe yarn: 3 ch, 19 dc (UKtr).

### THE FRONT BANDS

### The bottom band

Rows 1 and 2: with royal blue yarn: 3 ch, 19 dc (UKtr).

### The top band

Rows 1 and 2: with taupe yarn: 3 ch, 19 dc (UKtr).

### MAKING UP

- Flatten out the squares and iron them into shape using a cloth.
- 2. With the orange yarn, assemble the multicoloured panels of the sides and back, wrong side in, using 1 row of sc (UKac). Put the blue section of the panels at the bottom.
- **3.** Repeat the process for the top, bottom and front strips of the house. Put the blue strip at the bottom.
- **4.** Cut the yarn and fasten off. Fit the crocheted cover around the supporting cardboard frame.

### THE CURTAINS

- 1. Cut the fabric in half to get two 40cm ( $15\frac{3}{4}$ in) squares, and sew a 2cm ( $\frac{3}{4}$ in) hem all round.
- 2. Pleat your curtains using an iron, then sew them into position on the inside of the taupecoloured band, using firm slip stitches.

### Tip

The yarn from each colour change can be worked into the first stitches of the next row to give a perfect finish:
