

Size: 55" x 39.5" (without fringes)

Level: Intermediate

Stitch glossary and abbreviations:

stitch: st make: mk skip: sk chain: ch slip st: sl st

single crochet: sc double crochet: dc

Increase: inc decrease: dec round: rnd

end of row/rnd: eor.

Corner-to-corner crochet: C2C technique Start at one corner and work back and forth diagonally until you reach the opposite corner.

Chart 1

This throw is worked in C2C diagonally (see glossary chart). Follow red arrows for direction and switch colors accordingly.

R1: insert hook into 4th ch from hook, 3 dc = first block. Turn to WS.

R2: Ch 6, start at the 4rth chain from hook, 3 dc, 1 sl st into the chain 3 of the first block, ch 3 + 3 dc in the first block side (see chart). Turn to RS.

R3: Ch 6, start at the 4rth chain from hook, 3 dc, 1 sl st into the previous block, ch 3 + 3 dc in the side of previous block, 1 sl st, ch 3, 3 dc in the side of the next block.


Continue following chart 1 switching colors accordingly. Fasten off and wevae in colors.

Crochet fringe tassel: Use both colors. Cut 4 yarn pieces, insert needle in place, fold yarn in half, pull yarn into loop, pull edges and release (1 tassel) repeat as many times it is required. Alternate colors, insert fringes 1 block apart on the short ends only.
