Geometric Floor Mat



Geometric floor mat *



These round motifs fit together to make any shape you wish.

MATERIALS

- * Jersey yarn (medium thickness): 1 ball each of electric blue, navy blue, royal blue, light grey, dark grey, pink, red and taupe
- * N/15 (10mm) crochet hook

TECHNIQUE USED

Crochet

STITCHES USED

- * Double crochet (dc)/UK treble (tr)
- * Slip stitch (slst)
- * Chain stitch (ch)

The mat consists of 31 circles and measures around 120 x 90cm (47 x 35½in). Feel free to adapt the number of circles to the size of mat that you want.

FOR EACH CIRCLE

Make 5 ch, join with 1 slst to form the starting ring.

Round 1: 3 ch, 15 dc (UKtr) into the starting ring. End with 1 slst into the third ch from the start of the round.

Round 2 (for half the mat's circles): 3 ch, 1 dc (UKtr) between the slst ending round 1 and the first dc (UKtr). 2 dc (UKtr) into each dc (UKtr) of the previous round. End with 1 slst into the third ch from the start of the round. You have 31 dc (UKtr). Fasten off.

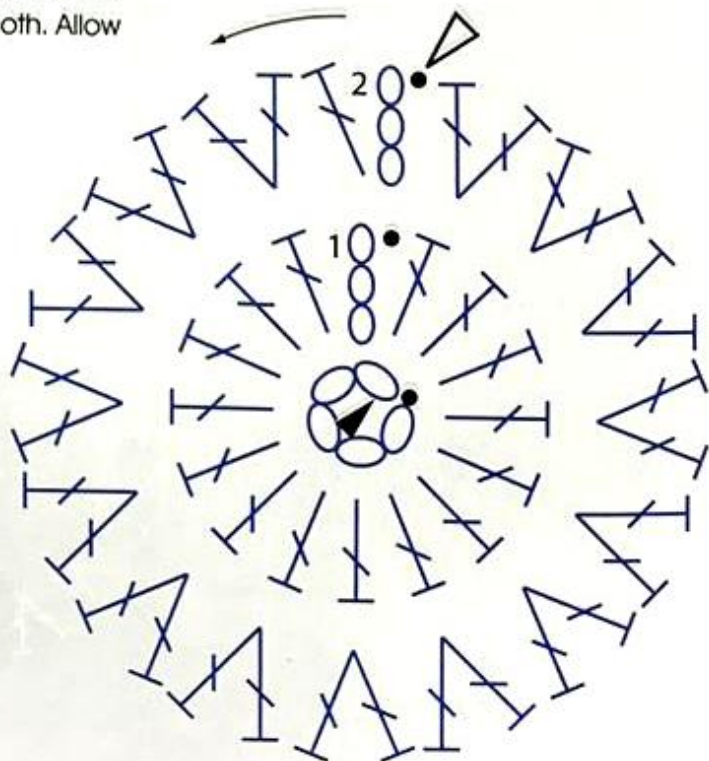
Flatten out the rounds and iron them into shape with a hot iron using a cloth. Allow to dry.

MAKING UP

1. Assemble the circles by knotting them together with a piece of grey yarn at the back of the work.
2. Work in the ends of the yarn.

Tip

Put the pieces of your mat together on the floor before starting to join up the circles so you can check that the spaces between the rounds are even.
