#### YOU WILL NEED

Yarn available at www.vardhmanknitworld.com / www.vardhmanyarns.com

- Woolista (WSM007, WSM021)
- Magnus (MSM025, MSM035)
- US N15 (10mm) crochet hook
- Stitch markers

#### GAUGE (TENSION)

8 sts and 5 rows measured over 4in/10cm of pattern, using US N15 (10mm) crochet hook.

#### NOTE

When working with super chunky one stitch is added to each piece for making up.

#### **GOOD TO KNOW**

- Yarn quantities are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.
- Instructions are written using US terminology with UK terminology given in italics in round brackets () afterwards.
- Repeat figures in square brackets [] the number of times stated afterwards.
- Instructions are given for the smallest size, with changes for the larger sizes given in round brackets () afterwards.
- Where only one figure is given, this relates to all sizes.
- Where the figure 0 appears, no stitches, times or rows are worked for this size.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

approx approximately

**bpdc(bptr)** back post double crochet (treble crochet): yrh, insert hook from back to front to back around vertical post of next stitch, yrh and draw up a loop, (3 loops on hook), yrh and draw through 2 loops, yrh and draw through all 2 loops on hook.

ch chain

cont continue

cm centimeters

**fpdc(fptr)** front post double crochet (*treble crochet*): yrh, insert hook from front to back to front around vertical post of next stitch, yrh and draw up a loop, (3 loops on hook), yrh and draw through 2 loops, yrh and draw through all 2 loops on hook.

**g** grams

hdc(htr) half double (half treble) crochet

in inches

**mm** millimeters

oz ounces

**pm** place marker



### SUNSHINE CARDIGAN



#### BACK

With N15 (10mm) crochet hook and A, ch 44(48:52:56:60:64:68), 1 sc(dc) into 2nd ch from hook and in each ch to end, turn. 43(47:51:55:59:63:67) sts.

1st row Ch 1, 1 hdc(htr) in each st to end, turn.

This row forms patt.

Cont in patt until work measures approx 251/4(251/4:26:26: 263/4:263/4:261/251/4:26:68:68:68:70)cm.

Fasten off.

#### FRONTS (MAKE 2)

With N15 (10mm) crochet hook and A, ch 16(18:19:21:22:24:26), 1 sc(dc) into 2nd ch from hook and in each ch to end, turn. | 15(17:18:20:21:23:25) sts.

1st row Ch 1, 1 hdc(htr) in each st to end, turn.

This row forms patt.

Cont in patt until work measures approx 251/4(251/4:26:26:263/4: 263/4:271/2)in/64(64:66:66:68:68:70)cm.

Fasten off.

#### SLEEVES (MAKE 2)

With N15 (10mm) crochet hook and A, ch 18(18:18:20:20:22:22), 1 sc(dc) into 2nd ch from hook and in each ch to end, turn. 17(17:17:19:19:21:21) sts.

Inc row Ch 1, [2 hdc(htr) in next st] 8(7:7:8:7:9:8) times, [3 hdc(htr) in next st] 1(3:3:3:5:3:5) times, [2 hdc(htr) in next st] 8(7:7:8:7:9:8) times.

35(37:37:41:43:45:47) sts.

1st row Ch 1, 1 hdc(htr) in each st to end, turn.

This row forms patt.

Cont in patt until work measures approx 13¾(13¾:13¾:13¾: 13:13:13)in/35(35:35:35:35:33:33)cm.

Fasten off.

#### CUFF

With right side facing out, using N15 (10mm) crochet hook and A, join yarn to side edge of cuff, ch 1, 1 sc(dc) in each st around bottom edge of sleeve, turn.

17(17:17:19:19:21:21) sts.

**1st row** Ch 3, (counts as 1 st), [1 bpdc(*bptr*) around next st, 1 fpdc(*fptr*) around next st] to end, turn.

**2nd row** Ch 3, (counts as 1 st) [1 fpdc(*fptr*) around next st, 1 bpdc(*bptr*) around next st] to end, turn.

Rep 1st row once more.

Fasten off.

#### TO MAKE UP

Join shoulder seams.

Join center of sleeve to shoulder seam and join sleeve approx  $8\frac{3}{4}(9:9:9\frac{3}{4}:10\frac{1}{2}:11)in/22(23:23:25:26:27:29)cm$  down each side of shoulder seam.

With right sides together, using yarn A, join side seams and shoulder seams using whip stitch.

#### WELT

With right side facing out, using N15 (10mm) crochet hook, join A to side corner of left front, ch 1, 1 sc(dc) in each st around bottom edge of cardigan, turn.

71(79:87:95:99:107:115) sts.

**1st row** Ch 3, (counts as 1 st), [1 bpdc(*bptr*) around next st, 1 fpdc(*fptr*) around next st] to end, turn.

**2nd row** Ch 3, (counts as 1 st) [1 fpdc(*fptr*) around next st, 1 bpdc(*bptr*) around next st] to end, turn.

Rep 1st row once more

Fasten off.

#### **NECK TRIM**

With the right side facing out, using N15 (10mm) crochet hook and A, join yarn to bottom corner of right front, ch 1, work 48(48:50:50:51:51:52) sc(dc) evenly spaced up front edge, 13(13:15:15:17:17:17) sc(dc) across back neck and 48(48:50:50:51:51:52) sc(dc) evenly down left front edge, turn. | 109(109:115:115:119:119:121) sts.

**1st row** Ch 3, (counts as 1 st), [1 bpdc(bptr) around next st, 1 fpdc(fptr) around next st] to end, turn.

**2nd row** Ch 3, (counts as 1 st) [1 fpdc(*fptr*) around next st, 1 bpdc(*bptr*) around next st] to end, turn.

Rep 1st row once more

Weave in any loose ends.

#### FLOWER MOTIF

1st, 2nd and 3rd size - make 14

Back - 4

Fronts - 3 each side

Sleeves - 2 each side

#### 4th, 5th and 6th size - make 19

Back - 5

Fronts - 4 each side

Sleeves - 3 each side

#### 7th size - make 24

Back - 6

Fronts - 5 each side

Sleeves - 4 each side

#### Petals

With N15 (10mm) crochet hook and B, [ch 14, pm] 4 times, ch 15, turn.

71 ch.

**1st row** Work 1 sc(*dc*) into 2nd ch from hook, and in each ch to end.

Fasten off.

Sew strip into flower shape using markers as the 5 center points. Sew center to secure.

#### Center bobble

With N15 (10mm) crochet hook and C, ch 4, 3 dc(tr) into furthest ch from hook, remove hook, place hook into starting ch loop, slip working st back onto hook and pull through and fasten off. Attach to center of each flower.

#### TO FINISH OFF

Attach flowers to cardigan using photo as a guide.
