

Two Color Basket



Two-colour basket



A round, multi-purpose basket, made in whatever colours you like.


MATERIALS

- Jersey yarn (bulky) thickness): 1 ball of royal blue
- # Jersey yarn (medium) thickness): 1 ball of fuchsia
- * 10mm (N/15) crochet hook

TECHNIQUE USED Crochet

STITCHES USED

- * Treble (tr)/ US Double crochet (dc)
- * Slip stitch (slst)
- * Chain stitch (ch)
- * Double crochet (dc)/ US Single crochet (sc)



With fuchsia yarn, make 5 ch, join with a sist to form the starting ring.

Round 1: 3 ch, 15 dc (UKtr) into the starting ring. End with 1 sist into the third ch from the start of the row.

Round 2: 3 ch, 1 dc (UKtr) between the sist joining round 1 and the first dc (UKtr). 2 dc (UKtr) into each dc (UKtr) of the previous round. End with 1 slst into the third ch from the start of the round. You have 31 dc (UKtr).

Round 3: 3 ch, then into the next 2 sts: *2 dc (UKtr) into the first st, 1 dc (UKtr) into the next.* Rep 15 times from * to.* Make 2 dc (UKtr) into the last st, end with 1 sist into the third ch from the start of the round. You have 47 dc (UKtr).

Round 4: 3 ch, then into the next 4 sts: *2 dc (UKtr) into the first st, 1 dc (UKtr) into each of the next 3 sts.* Rep 10 times from * to.* You have 3 sts left: 2 dc (UKtr) on the first


sts. End with 1 slst into the third ch from the start of the round. You have 59 dc (UKtr).

Round 5: 3 ch, then into the next 6 sts: *2 dc (UKtr) into the first st, 1 dc (UKtr) into each of the next 5 sts.* Rep 8 times from * to. * You are left with 5 sts: 2 dc (UKtr) into the first st, then 1 dc (UKtr) into each of the remaining 4 sts. End with 1 sist into the third ch from the start of the round. You have 69 dc (UKtr).

Cut the yarn, leaving around 10cm (4in). Flatten out and press into shape with a hot iron using a press cloth. Allow to dry. Round 6: with blue yarn: 1 ch, then 68 sc (UKdc). Make sure you work the fuchsia yarn into the first blue sc (UKdc)s to hide it. End with 1 slst.

Round 7: 1 ch, 68 sc (UKdc). End with

Round 8: 1 ch, 68 sc (UKdc). End with 1 sist.
