Approx. size: 8.75" Level: Intermediate

Material

Crochet hook C-2
Tapestry needle
Polyester stuffing
Scissors
Vardhman's given yarns in Almond,
Hydrangea and Mauve color

Dark brown yarn scraps

Stitch glossary and abbreviations:

stitch: st skip: sk chain: ch slip st: sl st single crochet: sc

double crochet: dc Increase: inc (2 sc in the same base

st)

invisible decrease: dec (insert hook into the front loops of the 2 next sts, yo, pull through 2 loops, yo, pull through 2 loops)

round: rnd/R

end of row/rnd: eor.

Head

Use color almond

Crochet in the round. Close rnds with 1

sl st. Make a magic ring.

R1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.

R2: 6 inc = 12 sc

R3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc

R4: 2 sc, 1 inc = 24 sc

R5: 3 sc, 1 inc = 30 sc

R6: 4 sc, 1 inc = 36 sc

R7: 5 sc, 1 inc = 42 sc

R8: 6 sc, 1 inc = 48 sc

R9: 7 sc, 1 inc = 54 sc

R10: 8 sc, 1 inc = 60 sc

R11 - 22 (12 rnds) = 60 sc in each rnd.

Insert stuffing as you start decreasing.

R23: 8 sc, 1 dec = 54 sc

R24: 7 sc, 1 dec = 48 sc.

R25: 6 sc, 1 dec = 42 sc

R26: 5 sc, 1 dec = 36 sc

R27: 4 sc, 1 dec = 30 sc

R28: 3 sc, 1 dec = 24 sc

R29: 2 sc, 1 dec = 18 sc

R30: 1 sc, 1 dec = 12 sc.

Insert more stuffing.

R31: $6 \, \text{dec} = 6 \, \text{sc}$

Use tapestry needle, weave the yarn through the front loop of each stitch in your last rnd, gently pull the yarn taught.

Ears (make 2)

Use color almond

Crochet in the round. Close rnds with 1

sl st. Make a magic ring.

R1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.

R2: 6 inc = 12 sc

R3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc

R4: 2 sc, 1 inc = 24 sc

R5: 3 sc, 1 inc = 30 sc

R6 - 8 (3 rnds) = 30 sc in each rnd.

R9: 3 sc, 1 dec = 24 sc

R10: 24 sc

R11: 2 sc, 1 dec = 18 sc

R12: 18 sc

Pattern Credit : CIRCULO

Fasten off with a tail for sewing. Sew ears onto head as shown in the picture.

R30 & 31: 24 sc in each rnd. Fasten off with a tail for sewing. Sew body onto head.



Body

Use color almond Crochet in the round. Close rnds with 1 sl st. Make a magic ring. Start at legs (make 2)

R1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.

R2: 6 inc = 12 sc

R3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc

R4 - 9 (6 rnds) = 18 sc in each rnd.

Switch to color hydrangea

R10 - 12 (3 rnds) = 18 sc in each rnd.

Fasten off. Make the second leg but

do not cut yarn.

R13 (join legs): ch 3, 18 sc in the first leg, 3 sc into chains, 18 sc in the second leg, 3 sc on the other loops of Switch to color hydrangea.

the chains = 42 sc

Switch to color mauve

R14: 42 sc

R15: 6 sc. 1 inc = 48 sc

Switch to color hydrangea.

R16: 7 sc, 1 inc = 54 sc

R17: 54 sc

Switch to color mauve

R18 & 19: 54 sc

Switch to color hydrangea.

R20: 7 sc, 1 dec = 48 sc

R21: 48 sc

Switch to color mauve

R22: 6 sc, 1 dec = 42 sc

R23: 42 sc

Switch to color hydrangea.

R24: 42 sc

R25: 5 sc, 1 dec = 36 scSwitch to color mauve

R26: 36 sc

R27: 4 sc, 1 dec = 30 sc

Switch to color hydrangea.

R28: 30 sc

R29: 3 sc, 1 dec = 24 scSwitch to color mauve Arms (make 2)

Use color almond

Crochet in the round. Close rnds with 1

sl st. Make a magic ring.

R1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.

R2: 1 sc, 1 inc = 9 sc

R3 - 6 (4 rnds) = 9 sc in each rnd.

Switch to color hydrangea.

R7 & 8: 9 sc in each rnd.

Switch to color mauve

R9 & 10: 9 sc in each rnd

Switch to color hydrangea.

R11 & 12: 9 sc in each rnd

Switch to color mauve

R13 & 14: 9 sc in each rnd

R15 & 16: 9 sc in each rnd

Switch to color mauve

R17 & 18: 9 sc in each rnd

Switch to color hydrangea.

R19 & 20: 9 sc in each rnd

Switch to color mauve

R21 & 22: 9 sc in each rnd

Fasten off with a tail for sewing.

Sew arms onto body.

Tail

Use color #7650 almond

Crochet in the round. Close rnds with 1

sl st. Make a magic ring.

R1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.

R2: 6 inc = 12 sc

R3 - 5 (3 rnds) = 12 sc in each rnd.

Fasten off with a tail for sewing.

Sew tail onto body as shown in the

picture.

Use dark brown yarn scraps to embroider eyes and nose as shown in the picture.
