Daisy Book Cover Crochet Pattern

By Hands of Zeal

Skill Level: Easy

Materials

5 mm H crochet hook

Scissors

Cotton Yarn

in white, candy lilac, and peach

Yarn needle

Button

Measurements

1 finished square is 4.5" x 4.5"

Abbreviations

Sc - single crochet

Hdc - half double crochet

Dc - double crochet

Tr - triple crochet

Dtr - double triple crochet

St - stitch

Sl st - slip stitch

Ch - chain

Yo - yarn over

Special Stitches

ESC – extended single crochet: insert hook into stitch and draw up a loop, yo and pull through one loop only, yo and pull through both loops on the hook.

EDC – extended double crochet: yo, insert hook into stitch and draw up a loop, yo and pull through one loop only, [yo and pull through 2 loops] – twice.

ETR – extended treble crochet: yarn over hook twice, insert hook into stitch and draw up a loop, yo and pull through one loop only, [yo and pull through 2 loops] – 3 times.

Daisy Square Instructions: Make 6
With white, start with a magic ring:

Round 1: Ch 3, 10 dc into the magic ring. Close round with sl st in first dc. (10 sts) Cut the yarn.

Join candy lilac into the same stitch where you made sl st:

Round 2: Ch 2, 2 hdc into the same stitch, 2 hdc in each dc around.

Close round with sl st in first hdc. (20 sts)

Round 3: Ch 3, [dc, tr] – into the same st, [tr, dtr, tr] – in next st, [tr, dc] – in next stitch, sl st in next st, *[dc, tr] – in next st, [tr, dtr, tr] – in next st, [tr, dc] – in next stitch, sl st in next st – repeat from * four times. Join with sl st. Cut the yarn.

Join peach color in dtr:

Round 4: Ch1, sc into the same st, ESC in next tr, hdc in next tr, dc in next dc, ETR in sl st, dc in next dc, hdc in next tr, ESC in next tr, [sc in next dtr, ESC in next tr, hdc in next tr, dc in next dc, ETR in sl st, dc in next dc, hdc in next tr, ESC in next tr] – repeat four times. Join with sl st in first sc.

Round 5: Ch3, [3 EDC, ch 1, 3 EDC] – into the same stitch, dc in next st, dc in next st, hdc in next st, hdc in next st, sc in next st, hdc in next st, hdc in next st, dc in next st, dc in next st, *[3 EDC, ch 1, 3 EDC] – in next st, dc in next st, dc in next st, hdc in next st, hdc in next st, sc in next st, hdc in next st, hdc in next st, dc in next st, dc in next st – repeat from * 3 times. Join with sl st in first EDC.

Take two squares and place them right sides together and whip stitch them together just on one side. Repeat the process with the remaining four squares. So you should have three segments now of two joined squares.

Now you are going to make a round of hdc around each segment.

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With peach, attach your yarn in any ch 1 sp on a corner. Ch 2.

Round 1: [2 hdc, ch 1, 3 hdc] in same sp, 1 hdc in each st across to the next corner, *[3 hdc, ch 1, 3 hdc] in the ch 1 sp of the corner, 1 hdc in each st across to the next corner*, repeat around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch 2. Finish off. Weave in ends.

Now take one of the segments and place it right sides together on

another segment and whip stitch along one long side. Then place the remaining segment right sides together and whip st them together along the bottom and sides. Weave in ends.

Turn right side out and place button in desired spot.

To make the button loop just attach your yarn in the center along the edge of the foldover segment. Make a ch of 3 and attach yarn back to the edge.
